Dinghy and Cruiser Parking Terms and Conditions 2019

Southwold Sailing Club offer Summer and Winter Dinghy and Cruiser parking to its members on a first come first served basis. We offer a total of 53 spaces made up of 13 dinghy spaces in the pen, 27 dinghy spaces and 13 cruiser spaces on the hard standing.

1. Dinghy and Cruiser storage is available to SSC members who have paid their subscriptions in full.
2. Applications can be made via the website or downloaded and completed forms can be posted or emailed to the Membership Secretary.
3. Summer storage is from April-October and Winter storage is from November to March.
4. Storage is only available once an application form with the correct information and fees have been approved.
5. A supplied sticker must be displayed on the transom of your dinghy/cruiser.
6. If your road trailer does not fit under your dinghy then it must be removed.
7. Boats must stay in their allocated plot.
8. Should the dinghy be sold, the Membership Secretary must be notified of the new owner.
9. The club shall at all times have a lien over a member or former members boat parked on the club premises in respect of monies owed as set out in rule 11 of part B in the Club Rules.
10. All dinghies must be securely tied down using the ground ties to prevent damage to other dinghies during a storm or flood. Insurance is recommended.
11. Boats must be kept in a tidy, mobile and serviceable condition.
12. Dinghies maybe moved around the dinghy park in order to carry out maintenance.
13. Plots on the hardstanding can be accessed by removing the shackle connecting the rope to the post. If a post obstructs a plot then the post can be removed. Please ensure the post and rope is replaced and any stones that fall down the post hole are removed.
